## Accommodations Overview

Three hotels are located in immediate vicinity of the Univeristy on Carling Avenue, about a 5 minute taxi ride or drive from the Campus.

## **How to Get to Carleton University**

Carleton University is located minutes south of downtown Ottawa. It is easily accessible by transit or by car from any direction of the city.

### **By transit**

The University is well served by OC Transpo. Local routes # 4 and # 7 both serve downtown and enter the campus. Check OC Transpo's website for specific times and routes [http://www.octranspo.com/new\\_menuue.htm](http://www.octranspo.com/new_menuue.htm). OC Transpo's new Light Rail System - [The OTrain](#) also provides service to Carleton University from the transit stations at Bayview (Lebreton Flats) and Greenboro (South Keys) with stops at Carling and Confederation Heights.

### **By car**

The main entrance to the University campus is located off Bronson Avenue at Sunnyside Avenue. Participants arriving from downtown can reach Bronson by following Laurier Avenue West. It is an approximately 10 minute drive, depending upon traffic. Participants should plan for extra time at the beginning and end of the days, due to traffic.

### **By taxi**

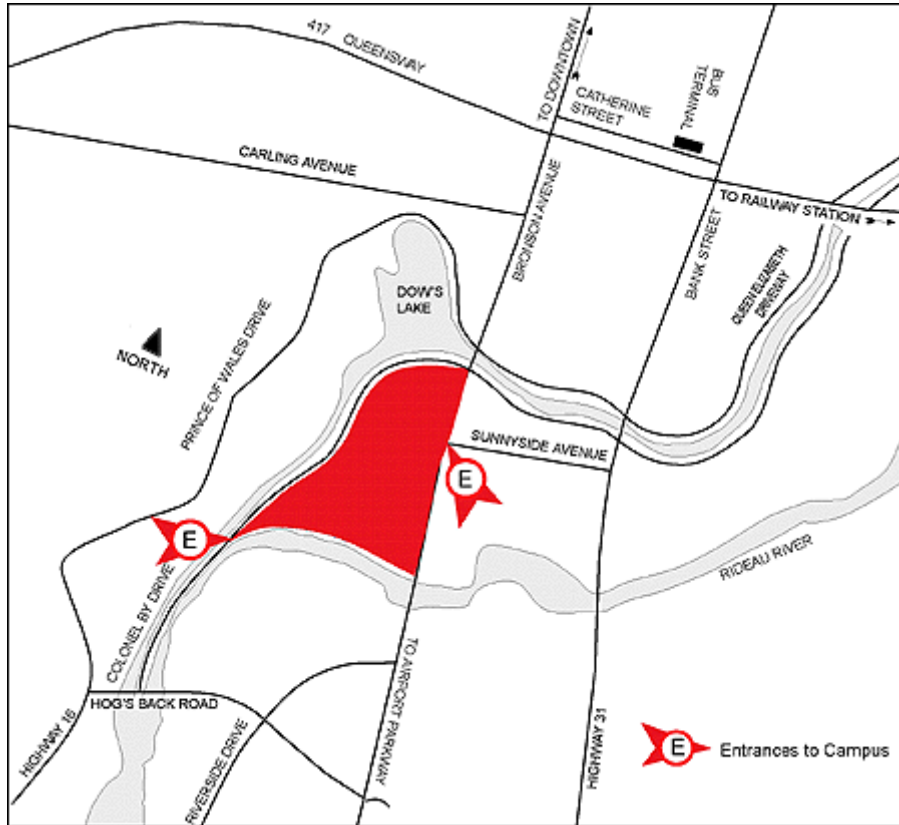
The campus can be accessed by taxi and a typical fare from downtown to the University is approximately \$15.00.

### **Arrival by Airplane**

The taxi ride from the Ottawa Airport to Carleton University's Residence Commons costs approximately \$15.00.
